


# Installing the FunkAmateur SPRAT CD - by Tony G4WIF


Press "Start", then Run




..... and then in the "open" box, type the name of your CD drive (in the above case it's "E:") followed by setup. The setup program will ask where to install the destination of the files and will default to the intriguingly odd "C:\Program Files\Theuberger Verlag GmbH\SPRAT on CD". If you don't go in for weird folder names, you can press the "browse" button and define another. In the example below "d:\data\sprat" was chosen.



When you run SPRAT CD for the first time it will prompt you to insert your personal startup disk. You won't need to do this when you subsequently use the CD Rom.

Next you will need to tell the SPRAT CD Rom software where on your PC your Adobe Reader software is located. Press the "Set Default ACROBAT Reader file path" button.




Press the area to the right of "look in" and select the drive where your acrobat reader

is located and then look for the folder. In the above example, it's called "acrobat". Double click that folder and inside you will likely find more folders as shown below:-




Double click on the "Reader" folder



... and then double click on the "AcroRd32.exe icon.

Finally, you need to click the button that says you agree to grass up anyone you know who pirates the CD.

So what if you've got to this point and found your copy of Adobe reader doesn't work or you haven't installed it yet. Well you get a second chance if you select  from the "Programs" menu, then ...

.... just to the right of "SPRAT", there is an Acrobat Reader button..



But! You haven't got a copy of Adobe Reader and you are now wondering why those nice people at FunkAmateur didn't put it on the CD. Fear not, you can download a copy from [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com) or perhaps a better idea is to buy a copy of PC Pro from your newsagent which almost always has a copy of Adobe on it's cover CD.

If it still doesn't work, then please remember that the GQRP club has no financial interest in the SPRAT CD and any defects should be reported to FunkAmateur who's contact details are on the CD's jewel case.
